**11: Pickard Hall (The Commons)**, Dining Hall, Heritage, Pickard and Mihaly private dining rooms, lunch and dinner discussions, Sensory Dining room, and coffee spot! Rooms B12 and B 18

**15: Scott Hall**, adult and family dorm building
